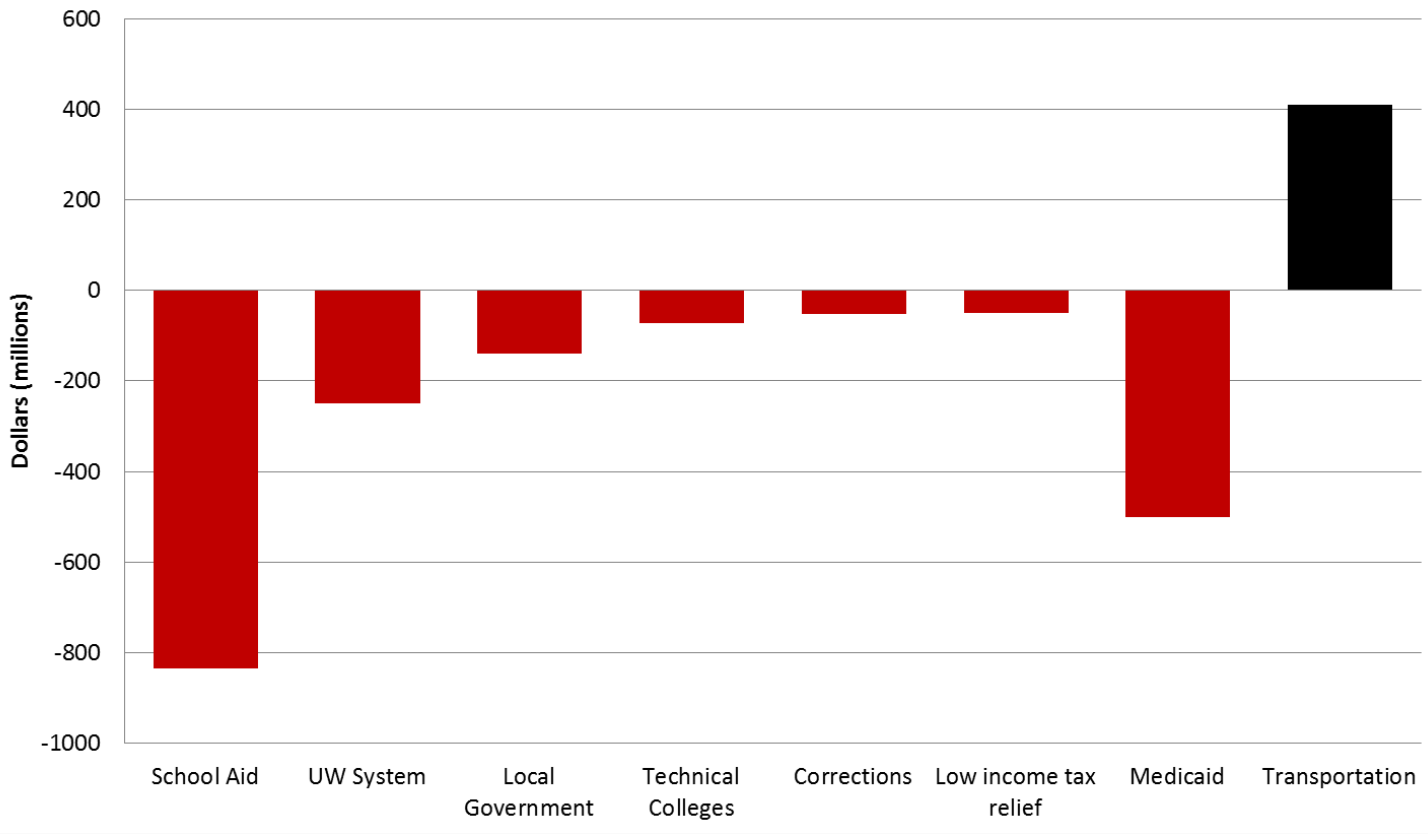

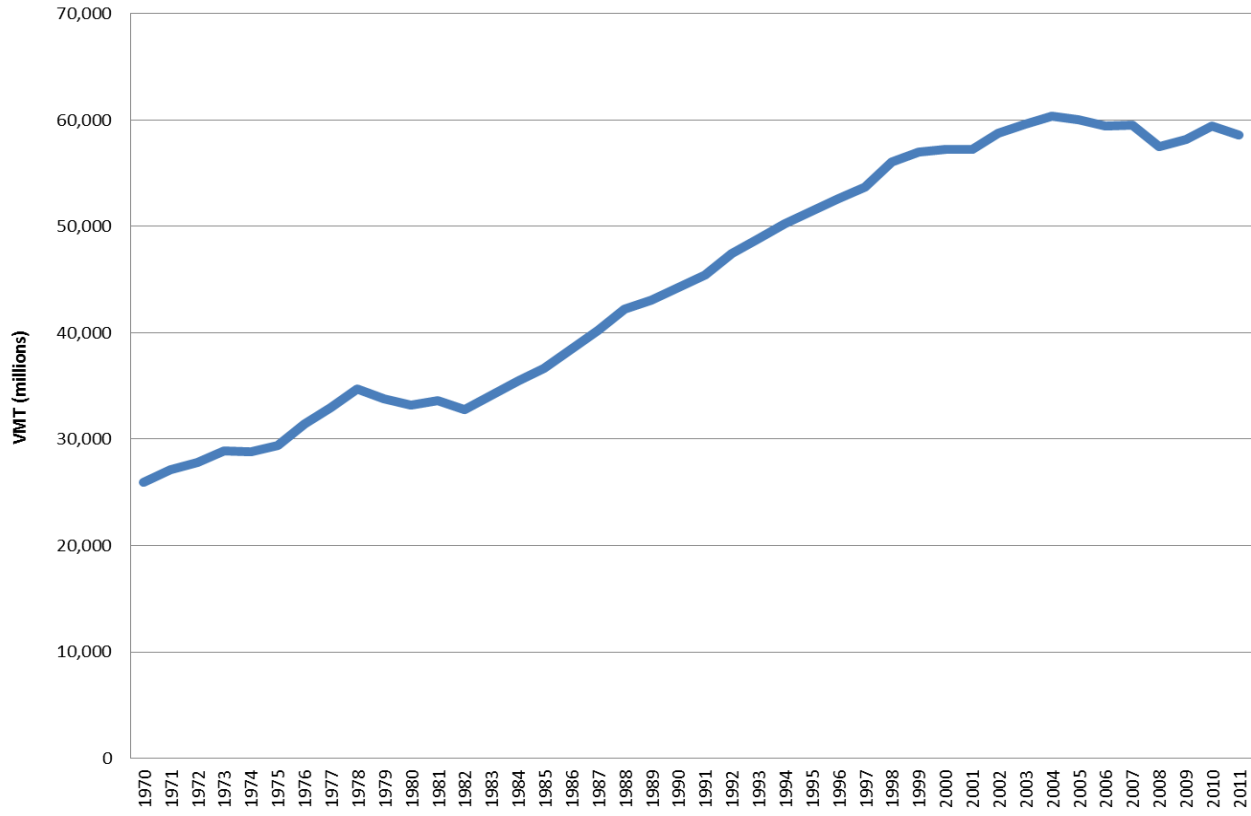

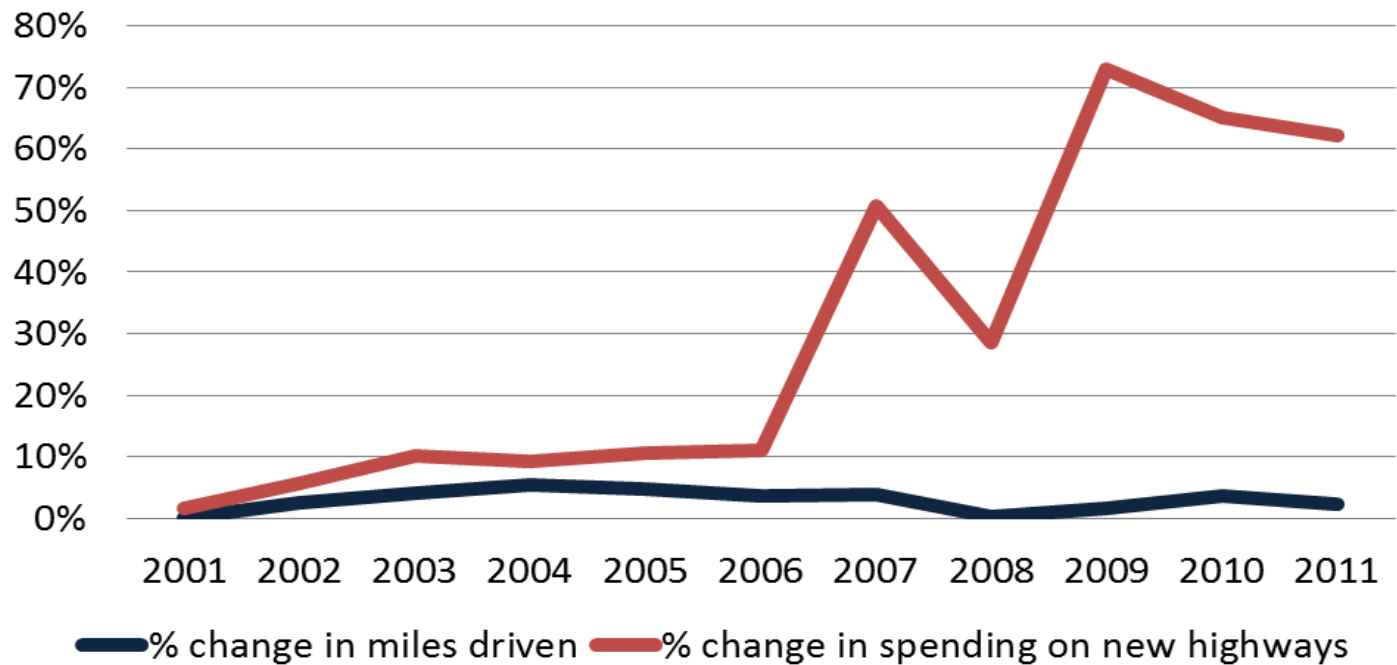
2011 Wisconsin Budget Changes



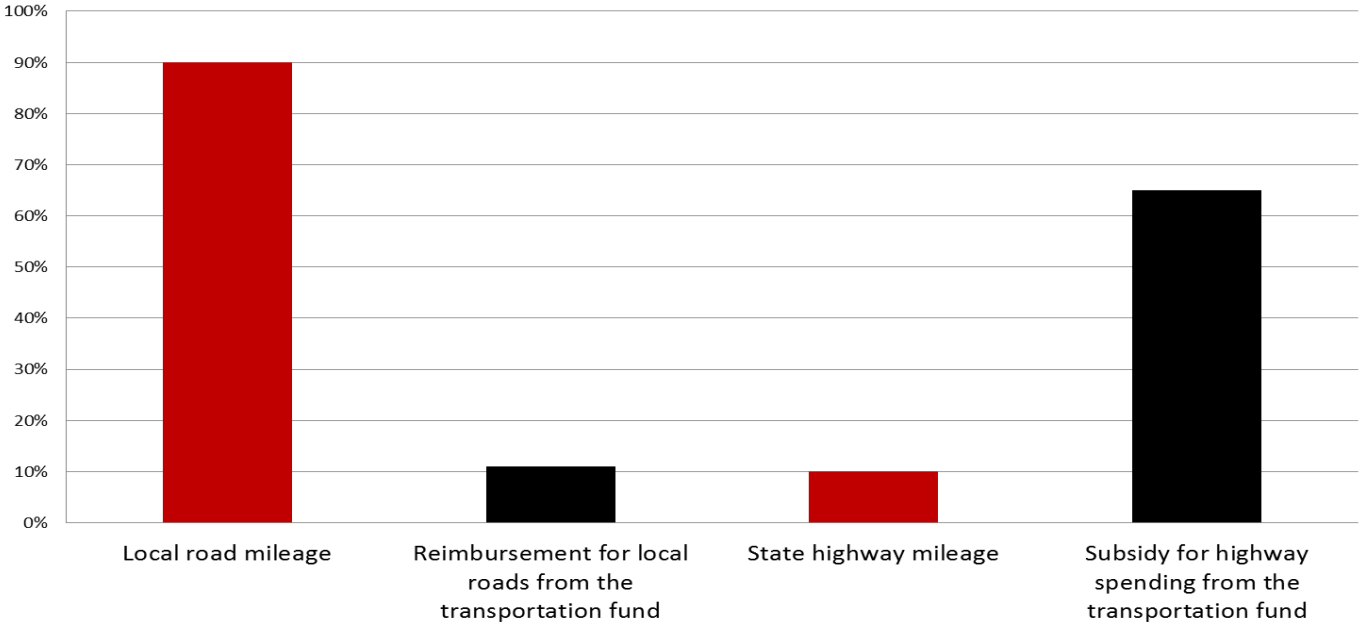
Vehicle-miles driven in Wisconsin



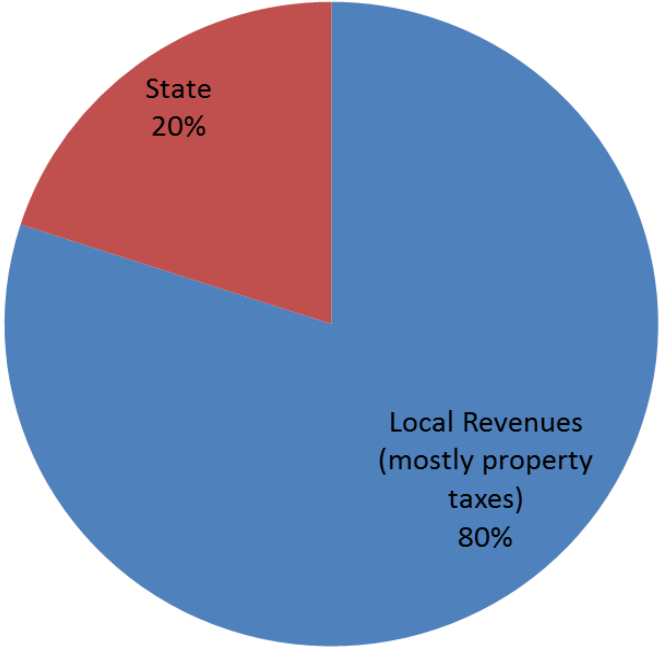
Percentage change in miles driven and new highway spending since 2000



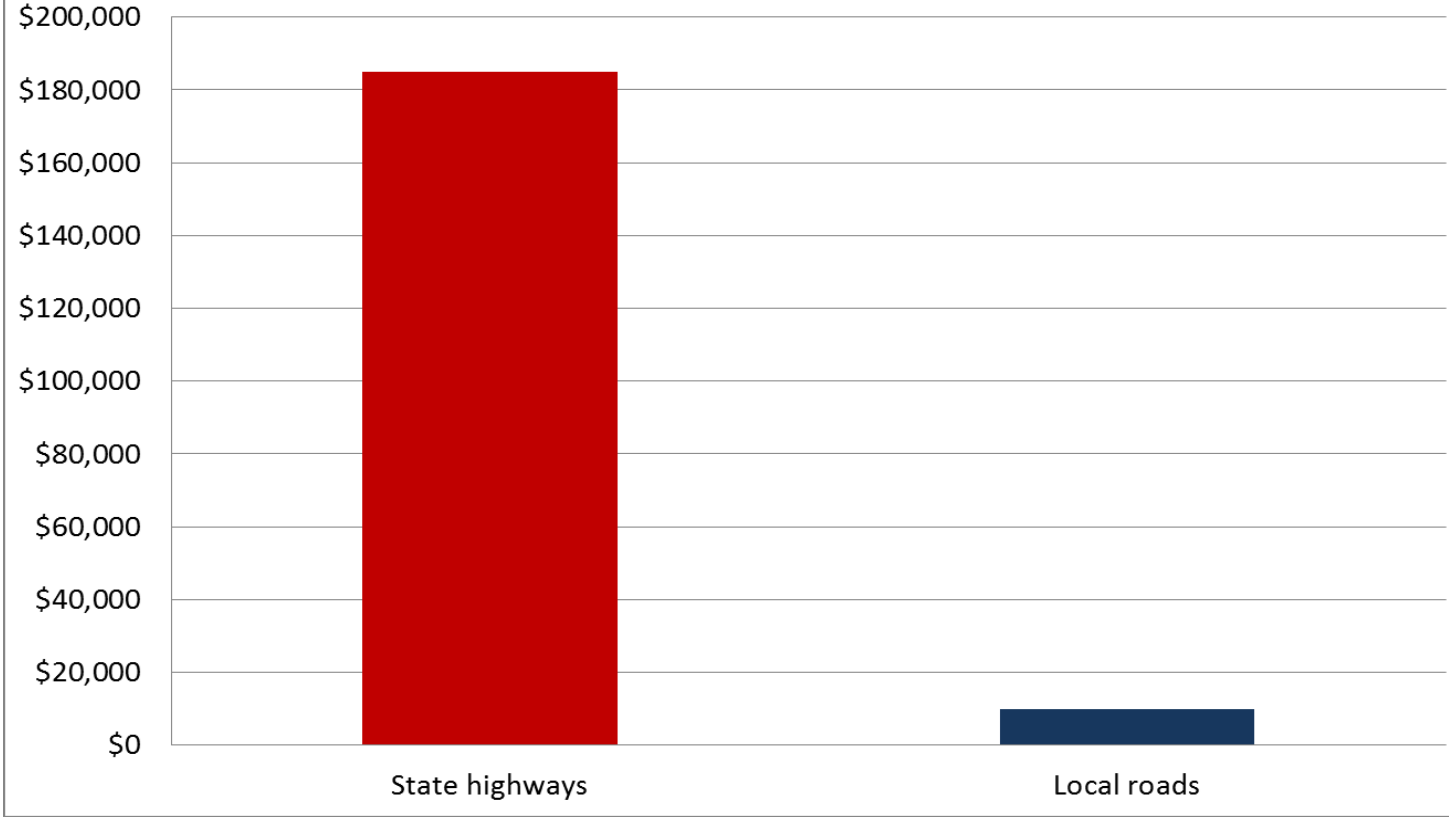
Miles of roadway compared to state allocation of Transportation Fund resources



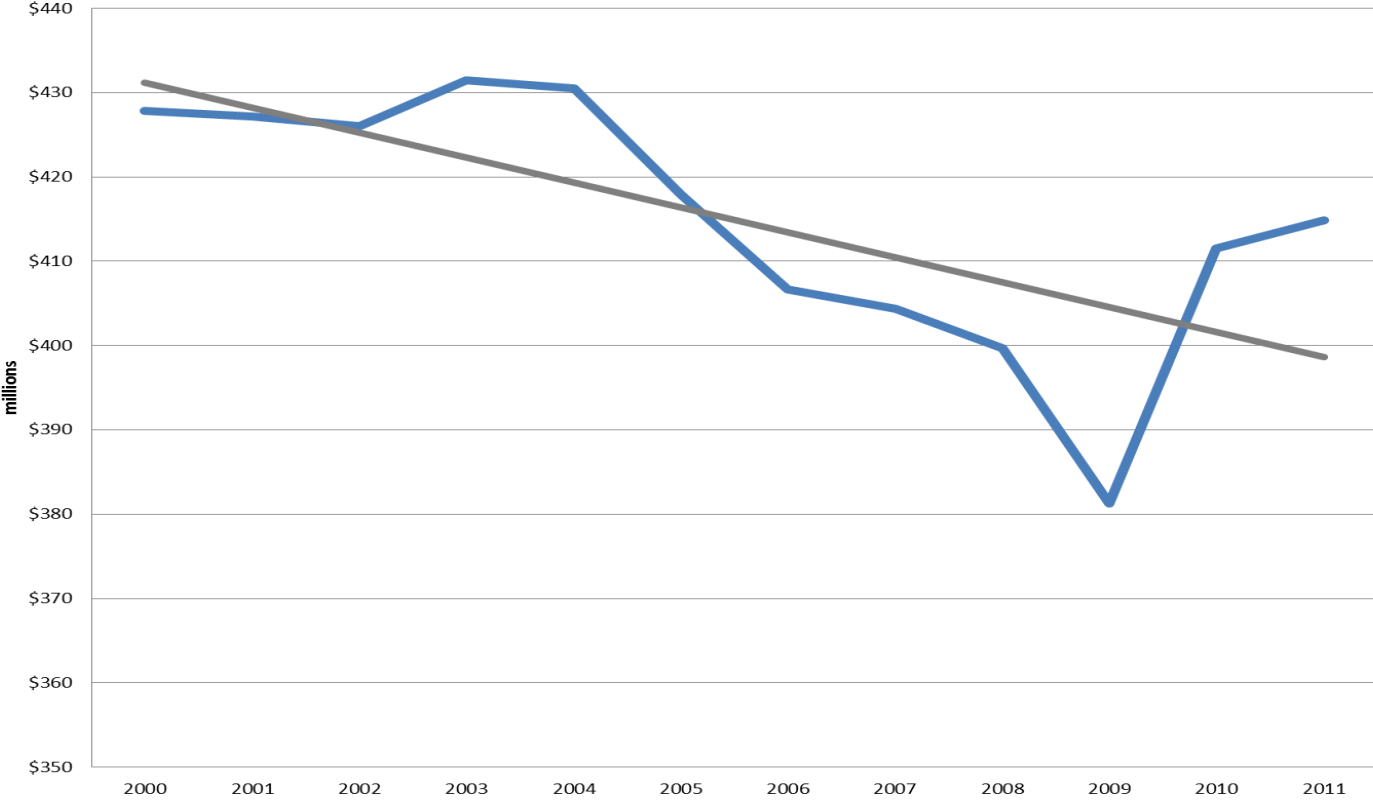
Average Local Road Funding Sources



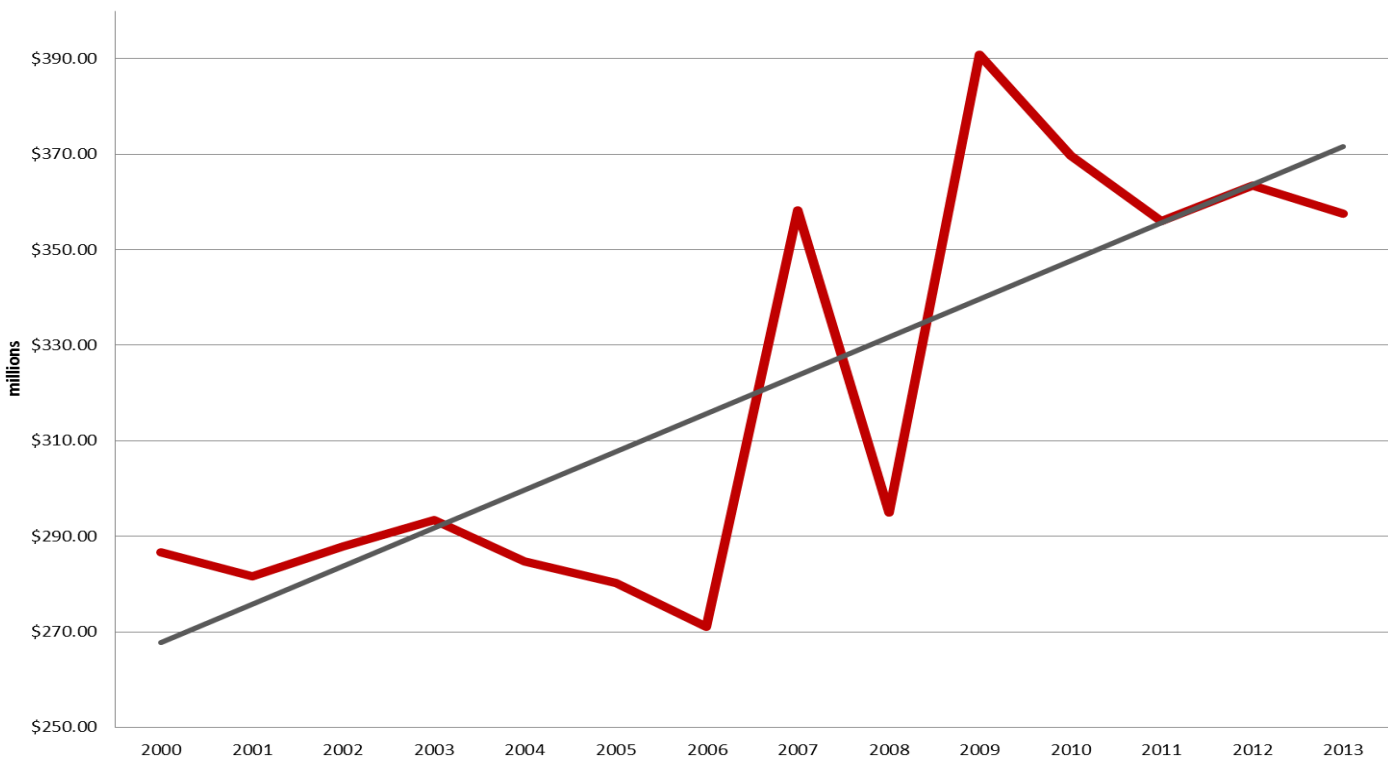
Annual state spending per mile of roadway



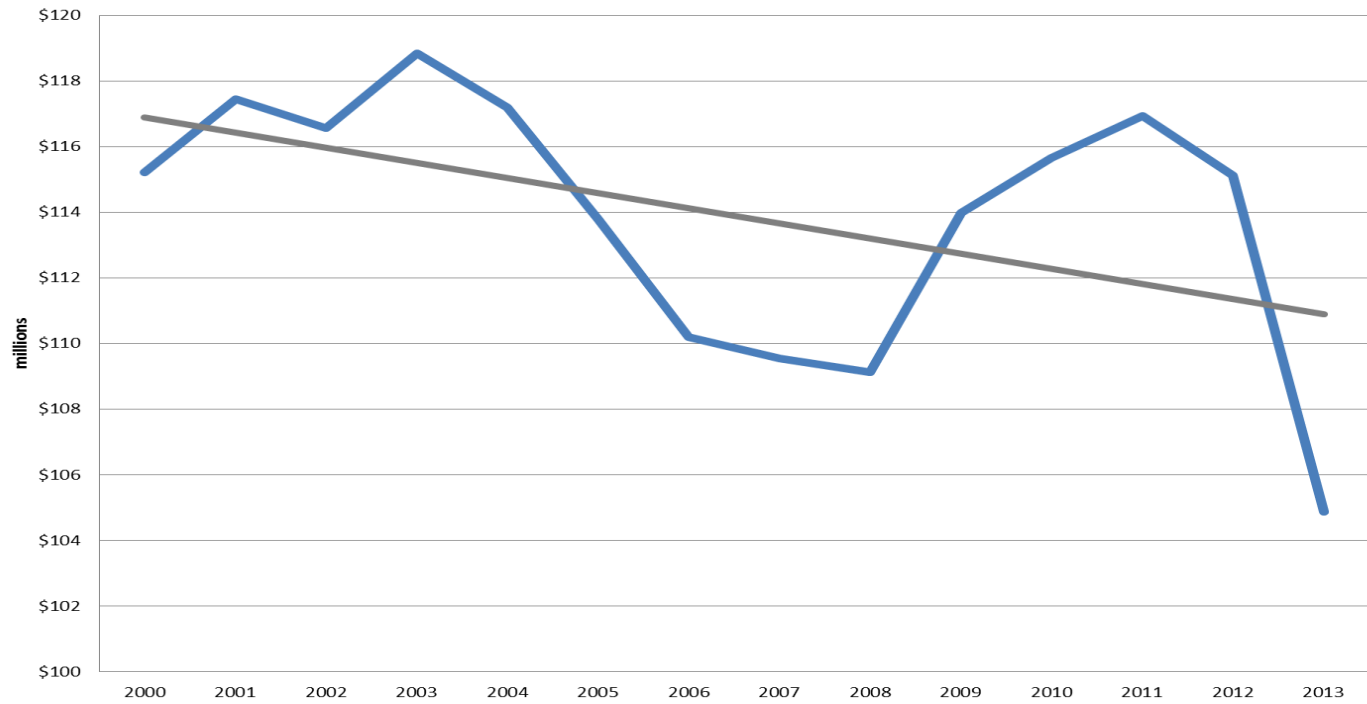
Local Transportation Aids (constant 2009 dollars)



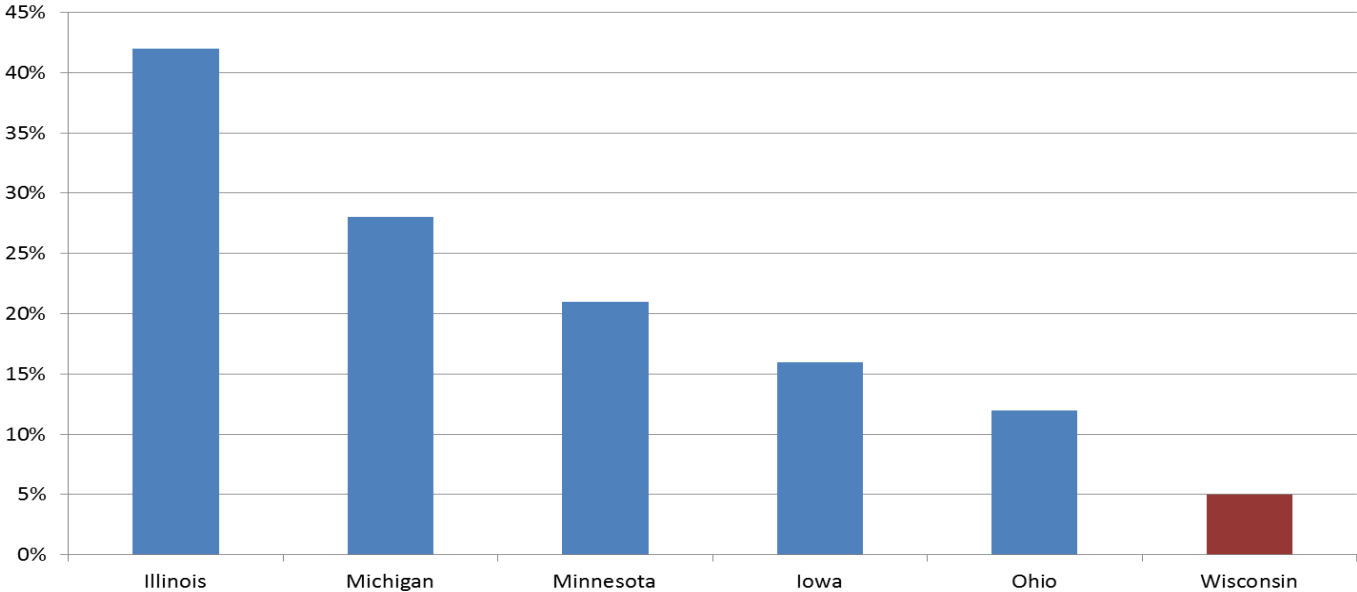
New Highway Capacity (constant 2011 dollars)



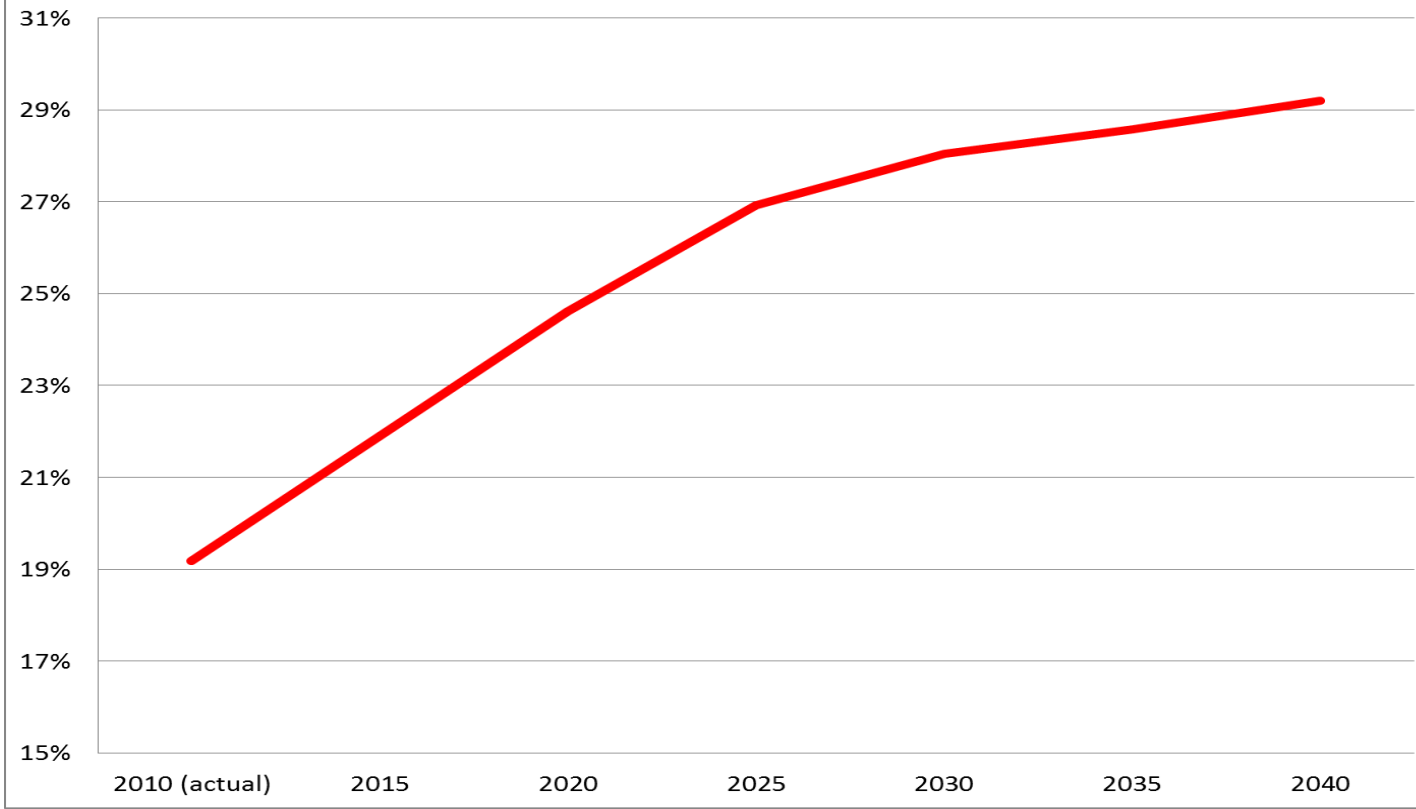
Transit Operating Aids, State Funds (constant 2011 dollars)



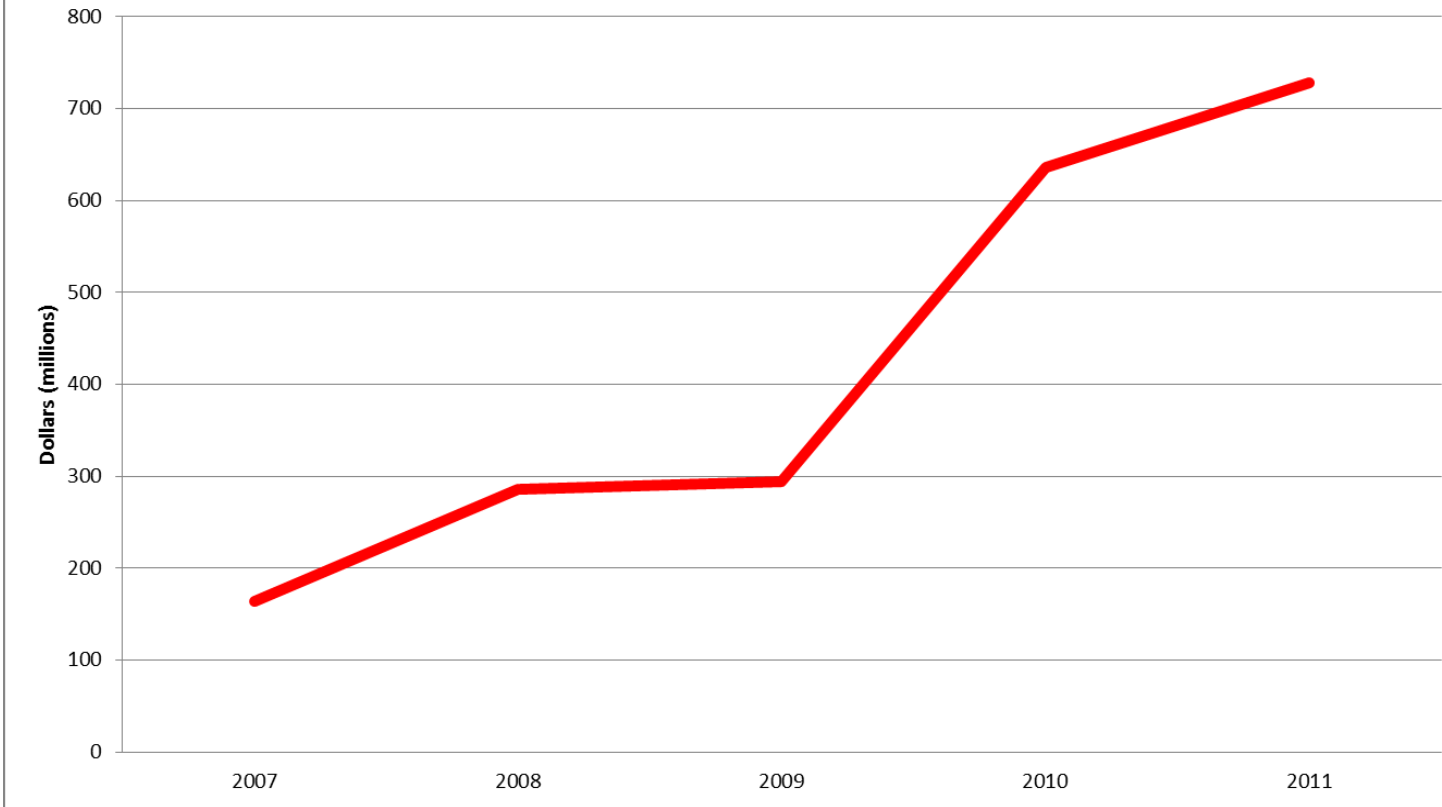
Allocation of federal transportation funds for transit in the Midwest

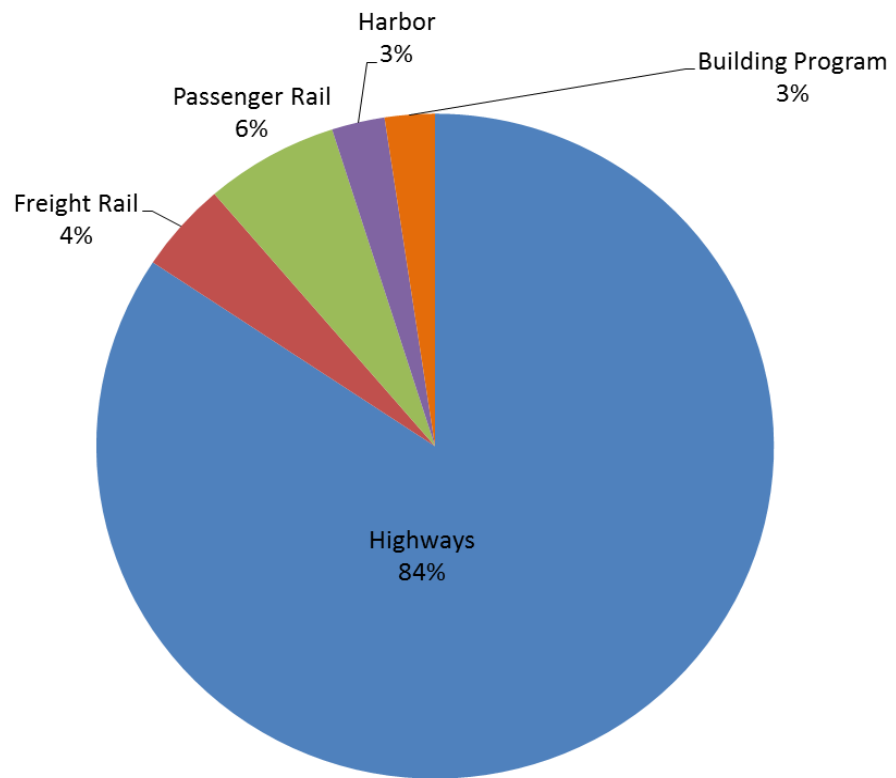


Projections for population aged 65 and above in Wisconsin
